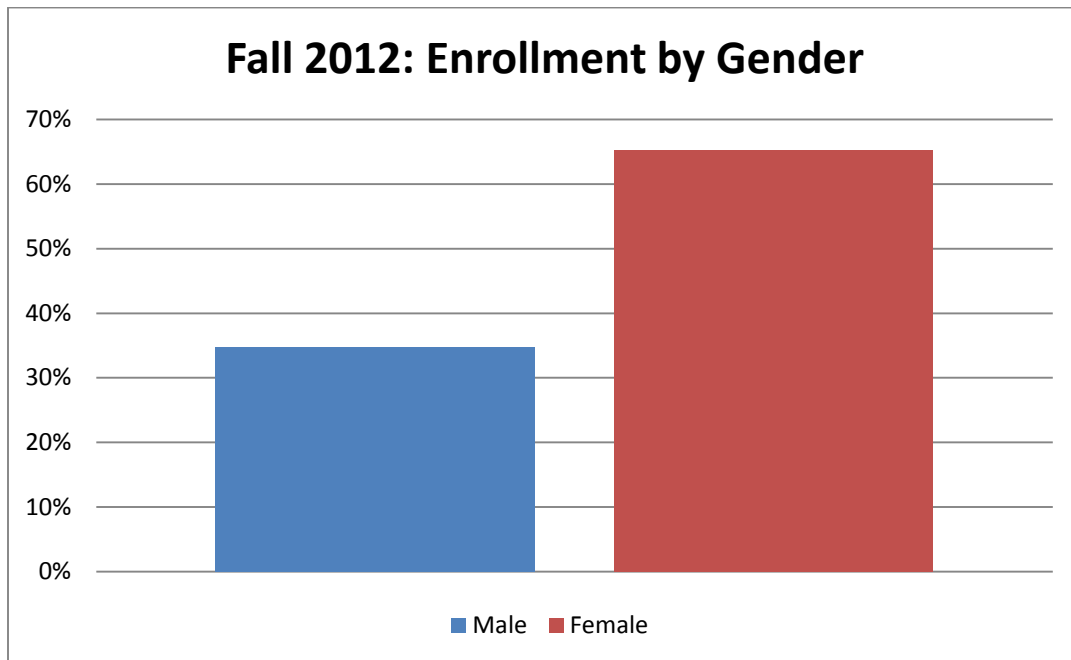

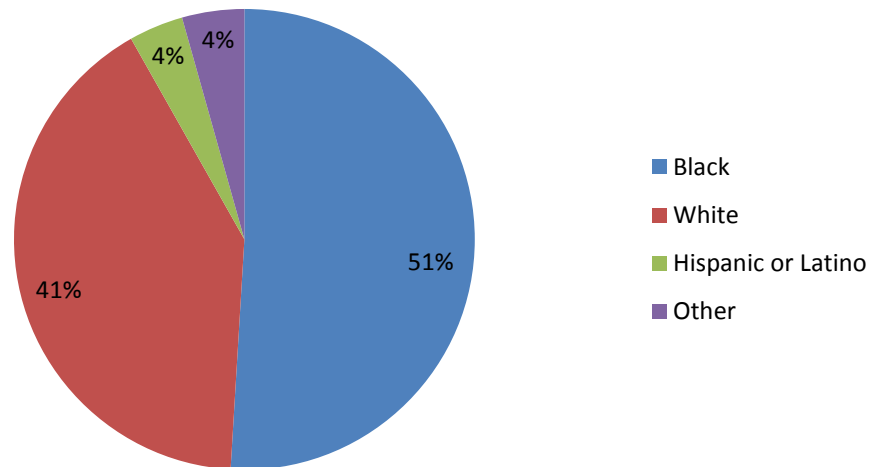

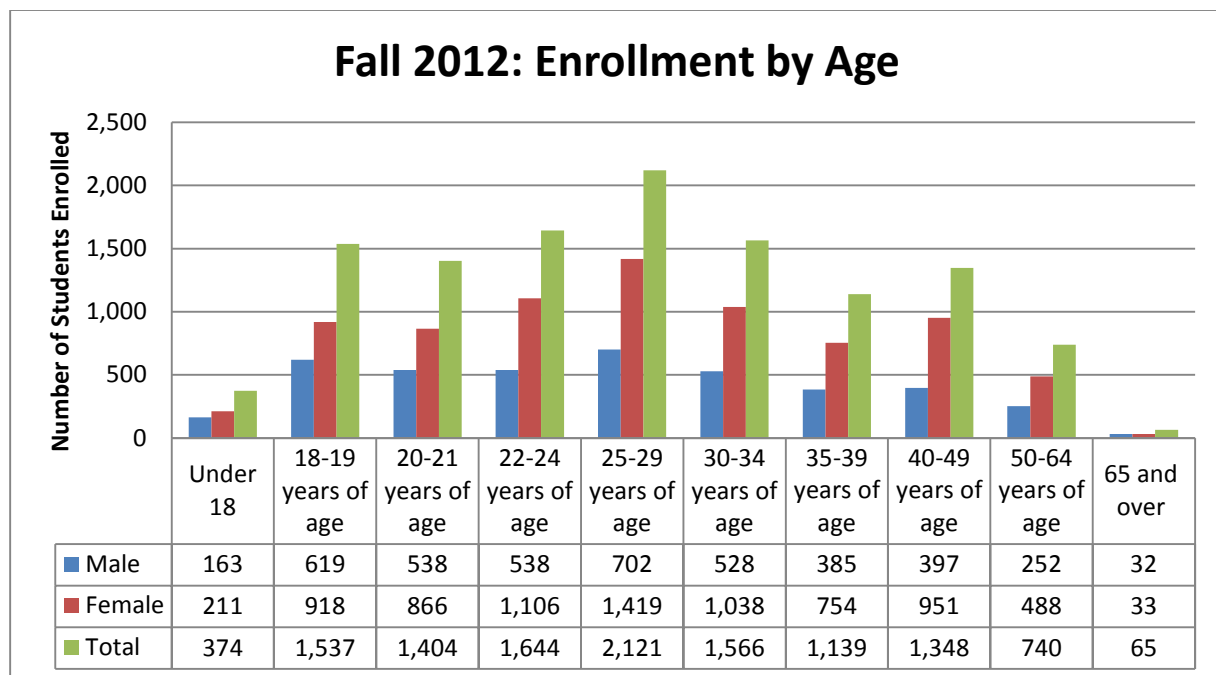
Fall 2012: Enrollment by Race & Ethnicity

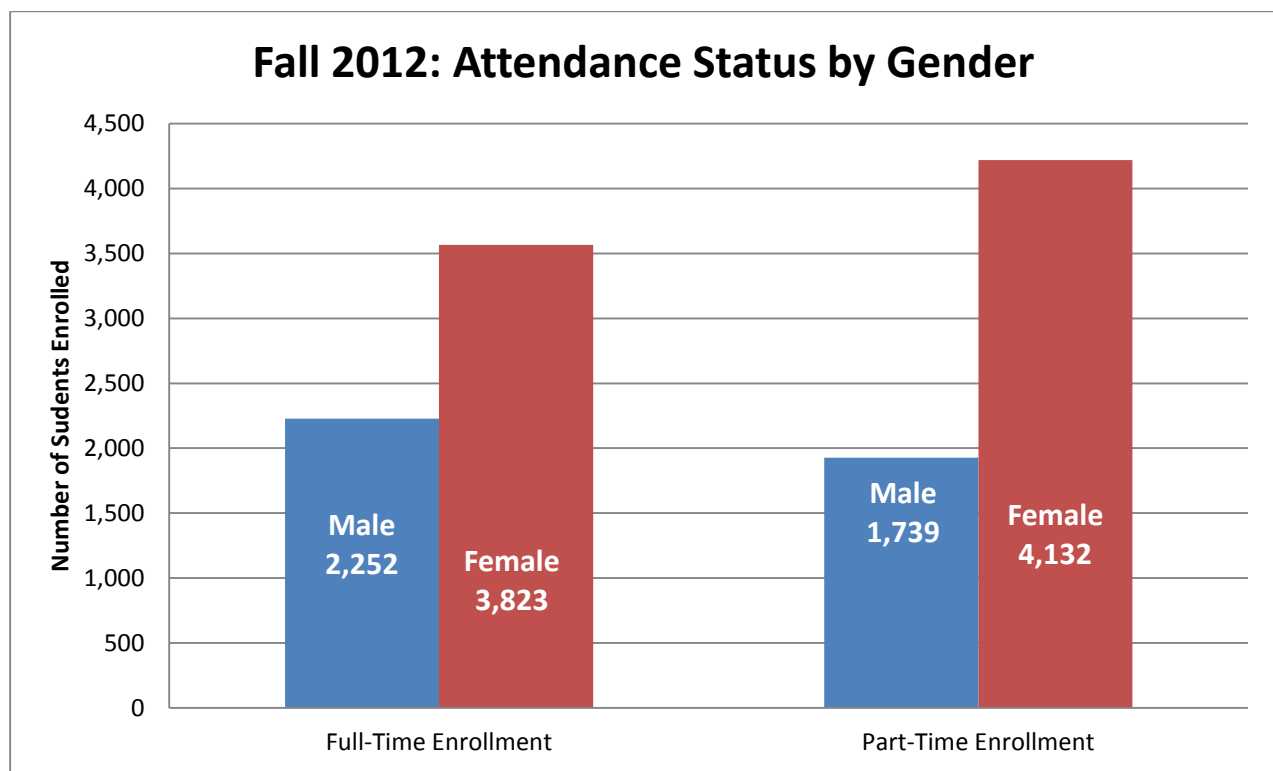

Fall 2012: Average Enrollment Age - 30

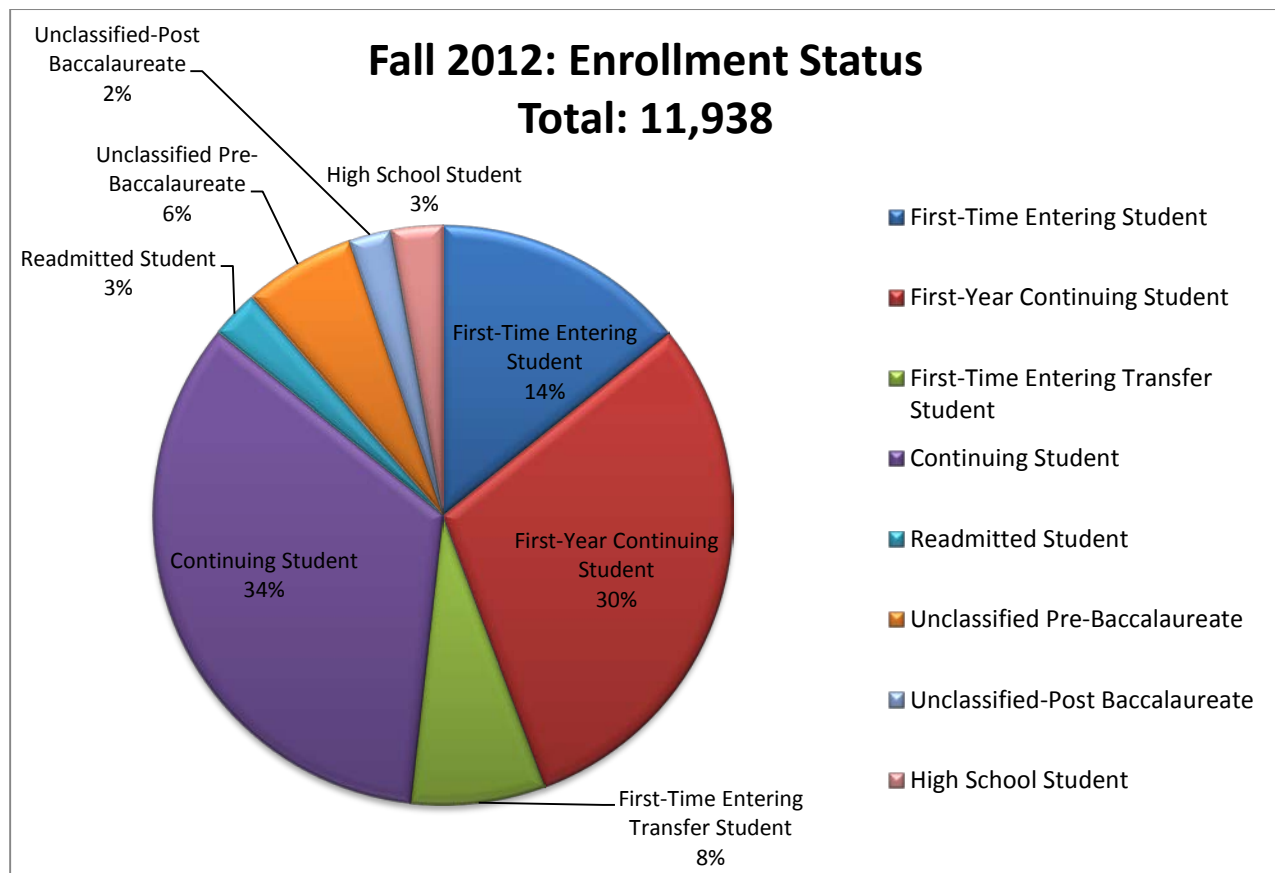


Fall 2012: Enrollment by Attendance Status
